

2017-18 Lunch-Time Supervision Service for Students in Grades 6 to 9

Grade 6 to 9 students who stay at school for lunch must be [registered in the lunch program](#). School staff provide supervision, so there is **no lunch-time supervision fee**. During the lunch hour, students are expected to:

- treat staff and other students with respect,
- demonstrate that they are responsible young adults who clean up after themselves and put garbage and recyclables in the appropriate containers, and
- transition quickly and quietly to classrooms when the bell rings.

From **11:32 to 11:54 am**:

- Students in eat lunch and socialize in one of the **flex areas** on the main floor or second floor.

From **11:55 am to 12:17 pm**, students may go to any of the following supervised areas:

- **Flex area on the second floor** for eating and socializing
- **Large gym** for physical activity
- **Library Learning Commons** for reading, homework, or participating in other quiet activities (i.e. playing board games)
- **Outdoors**, weather permitting, for fresh air and physical activity

Leaving the School Grounds during the Lunch Hour

Grade 6 and 7 students are not permitted to leave the school grounds during the lunch hour.

Grade 8 and 9 students may leave the school grounds (e.g. to walk to the local park or Ambleside commercial building, go to a friend's for lunch) only if they have **written permission from a parent/guardian**.

Please review with your son/daughter the following *behaviour expectations for students who have permission to leave the school grounds during the lunch hour*.

- Exit the school via the front entrance only.
- Walk to your destination on the sidewalks, not through the school field.
- Use garbage cans/recycle bins for all food wrappers, trash and drink containers.
- Interact in a polite and respectful manner with with store clerks and other customers (i.e. give way to adult customers).
- Return to school on time for afternoon classes.
- Put all food items and beverages away in lockers before entering the gym or library learning commons (before 11:55 am). Students who have not returned to school by 11:55 am are expected to stay outside until the bell rings at 12:17 pm.
- Refrain from bringing food items or beverages, other than water, to class (unless permission has been given by a teacher).

Due to time restrictions and traffic volume, it is not recommended that students walk to the Currents shopping areas during the lunch hour.
